

FACILITY BIOSECURITY STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES



United Animal Health Personnel

- Plant staff wear dedicated footwear before entering the manufacturing and warehouse areas.
- Personnel without dedicated footwear must walk through foot baths before entering the manufacturing and warehouse areas.
- Employees who own or come in contact with livestock shower prior to reporting to work wearing clean laundered clothes and clean footwear.

Visitors & Non-staff

- Proper facility signage is displayed to direct visitors to correct entryways.
- All visitors report to the office and sign the visitor log.
- UAH staff monitors visitor sign in prior to authorizing access.
- Controlled zone lines in manufacturing and warehouse areas are established to restrict visitors to areas within the plant.
- Authorized visitors walk through foot baths before entering the manufacturing and warehouse areas.
- Customers are encouraged to call-in their order and remain in their vehicles.

Bulk Ingredient Receiving

- Bulk ingredient pit is covered when not in use, prior to trucks pulling over and leaving the pit.
- Funneling devices are used to limit the quantity of material that falls onto the floor of the receiving bay.
- Product spilled on the receiving bay floor is swept up and discarded.

Facility Hygiene

- Entryways are secured by keeping doors and screens closed to manufacturing and warehouse area to protect against walk-ins and pests.
- Screen doors are utilized to allow ventilation during warm months.
- Plant floors are scrubbed and disinfected once a week when conditions allow.
- Conduct routine facility and truck pathogen testing.
- Livestock, livestock trailers and livestock truck boxes are prohibited on grounds.
- Foot baths are used before entering mill buildings, manufacturing and warehouse areas.

Customer Sampling & Returned Goods

- Customer feed and ingredient samples are submitted directly to a lab and not mill offices.
- Customer samples are not allowed to be transported on feed delivery trucks.
- Feed products are not allowed to be returned and/or transferred between farms.
